What is the Cancer Care Quality Program?

The Cancer Care Quality Program helps improve quality and manage costs for cancer care. The program recognizes value and enhances patient outcomes.

Importantly, the Program also supports oncology practices in the following ways:

Providing actionable information

When your practice requests coverage for a cancer treatment regimen and submits it to Carelon for review, it is compared against a comprehensive database of current, evidence-based cancer treatment regimens. In cases where the requested regimen is not aligned with any of the evidence-based regimens, information on alternatives will be presented.

Pathways developed and reviewed by oncologists

Pathways are developed using a rigorous process of evidence-based medicine. Cancer Treatment Pathways are selected from therapies recommended by national guidelines on the basis of:

- Clinical benefit (efficacy)
- Side-effects (toxicity), especially those that lead to hospitalizations or impact quality of life
- Strength of national guideline recommendations
- Cost

Up-to-date

Standards of oncologic care evolve rapidly and keeping pace with change is vital to the health of your patients. That's why it's important to know that the Cancer Treatment Pathways identified in our Program are updated through a systematic review of medical evidence, at least quarterly, and more often when new treatments emerge or national guidelines change. Through the rigor of this process, we maintain an up-to-date source of Cancer Treatment Pathways.

How to participate

The first step in participating is to register as a user of the Anthem Cancer Care Quality Program via the **ProviderPortal**, an online application, at www.providerportal.com. The **ProviderPortal** allows you to initiate a review of cancer treatment regimens for your patients who are covered by participating health plans. We call this the "order request" process.

The **ProviderPortal** allows you to:

- Submit a new order request
- Update an existing one
- Retrieve your order summary

It also offers you access to identified Cancer Treatment Pathway regimens, according to your patients' clinical information and your requested services.
